Message from the Vice President

"Dear Diplomates and Residents,

At the last AGM in Berlin, I was chosen as the new Vice President. This means I will be the right hand of Daniela, our new President for the next 2 years. I am really honoured and will try being available for you all.

I will shortly introduce myself for people who don't know me. I graduated at the University of Ghent in 2004. From 2004 till 2009, I did my internship and residency at the Ambulatory Clinic of the Department of Reproduction, Obstetrics and Herd Health, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Ghent University. During these years, I also did a PhD entitled "Calving problems and calving abilities in the phenotypically double muscled Belgian Blue breed". After my PhD defence, I stayed at the Faculty to do herd health visits, problem herd health visits, teach students and work in the ambulatory clinic.
